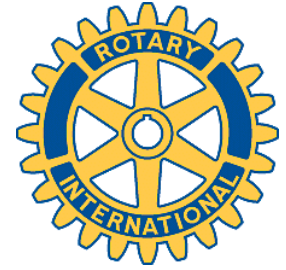


CANYON COUNTY SUNRISE ROTARY
